Host An Event

What is a Third-Party Fundraiser?

Third party fundraisers are an event or initiative organized by an individual, company, or community organization that is not an official Childcan event but benefits Childcan's work, people, and participants. Acting independently and with Childcan's approval, third party fundraisers are an important resource for raising funds and increasing awareness of the organization.
