



Treatment-Related Medical Travel Program Registration

Effective November 1, 2016, Childcan initiated a pilot program covering a portion of medical travel to unscheduled hospital visits or admissions. The intention of the program is to offset the void left by changes to the Canadian Cancer Society's medical transportation program, and to be used only when the volunteer driver program, "Wheels of Hope", is not applicable.

Childcan's program will reimburse treatment-related medical travel within the following parameters:

- The distance between home and the nearest treatment facility is between 50 and 199 kilometres, one way;
- The hospital visit or admission is unscheduled or scheduled with less than three business days' notice, making it ineligible for a volunteer Canadian Cancer Society driver to be booked;
- The child is on active treatment; and
- The child/family is registered with Childcan.

Childcan will be reimbursing at a rate of \$0.20 per kilometre with the intention of covering fuel costs only, not vehicle wear and tear.

We will require prior registration through the completion, submission and approval of this form.

We will require the completion and authorization of our program-specific reimbursement form.

Registration

I wish to register my child for Childcan's Treatment-Related Medical Travel Program. I understand the above parameters and confirm that my child is on active treatment. Whenever possible, I will first try to facilitate travel through the Canadian Cancer Society's volunteer driver program, "Wheels of Hope", and will resort to Childcan's program when my child's hospital visit or admission is unscheduled or scheduled without the sufficient three-business-day notice to secure a Canadian Cancer Society volunteer driver. I understand this is a pilot program which may be altered or canceled at any time.
